

## Parents & Teachers of Eastview (PTE) Minutes of May 8, 2014 Meeting

7:05 P.M. - Meeting called to order

Kelly Jatczak called the meeting to order and welcomed the parents and Ms. Magnuson. Minutes from the April 7, 2014 PTE meeting were presented for review by Kelly and the floor was opened for questions. Yvonne Mundorf moved to approve the amended minutes from the April meeting. Lisa Medendorp seconded - 7 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 abstention - motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report** A current ledger of PTE income and expense was provided to all in attendance. Gigi Bendis provided an explanation the recent deposit of a \$0.68 deposit from Escript. \$500.00 was raised in Change Wars contributed by Mrs. Flick's science classes. \$5886.00 deposited from the Butterbraid fundraiser and a check in the amount of \$3502.00 for Butterbraids cost was issued for a total profit of \$2883.00 for this fundraiser. No other activity was reported. Lisa Medendorp moved to approve the Treasurer's report. Yvonne Mundorf seconded, 7 in favor, 0 opposed, 1 abstention - motion carried.

### Committee Reports

Butterbraid Sale - Jane Serbus and Christi Peblanski forwarded a report to Kelly Jatczak that the sale went very well. Butterbraids arrived from the company ready for delivery. Delivery went very well. Proceeds from sale will go to purchase locks for a number of the remaining classrooms. Jane and Christi have offered to chair this committee for the 2014-15 school year.

Dance Committee - The final dance of the year will be the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Dance to be held on Thursday, May 29<sup>th</sup> from 7 pm to 9 pm. A request for a total of 10 parent volunteers to chaperone and for snacks will be sent out. Any donations can be dropped off in the office the day of the event.

Citizen's Advisory Council (CAC) - The next CAC meeting will be May 8<sup>th</sup> at Elgin High School. Voting to take place on reports presented through out the year. Reports are available for viewing on the CAC website available through the U-46 website.

Box Top - Yvonne Mundorf reported that participation in the program is low. She currently does not have the minimum number of box tops to submit.
