■ **Treasurer's Report**

- 117 families have paid PTE membership fees. PTE asked for \$30 per family. Currently there are approximately 925 students registered at Eastview.
- Step up to reading needs to be paid. The program is ordered. The program is tied to common core. Good news: Each is 10 cent less expensive this year.
- The proposed budget for 2014-2015 is \$3500. Last year, the PTE raised \$3100. Funds raised so far this year, are \$2975.
