▪ **Administration Report - Donald Donner**

- PARCC Testing to begin 3-9-15. Monday and Tuesday are the Math portion of the test, and Wednesday through Friday are the language portion. All tests will be taken pencil and paper. 2 Years from now, all tests will be taken on the computers.
- Wireless is coming, potentially in December of 2015. Older computers have been switched out for newer ones. All preparation for computerized PARCC testing.

- MAP testing to take place in mid-April for 7th grade students and 8th graders with IEPs. This will be a shortened version and there are just 20 questions.
- The district announced that the parking lot will be redone. The parking lot to the loading dock will be done during the summer 2015.
- Additionally, all of the piping throughout the school will be replaced as the pipes are all very old.
- Two other improvements include new bleachers in the gym and lighting for the flag.

We will need baked items to be donated in small portions to be sold during the book sale as an additional fundraiser.
